Treasurer Vacancy

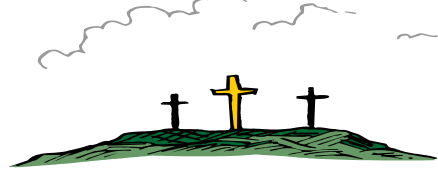
