**Church Tent, New Forest and Hampshire County Show
Tuesday 26 July - Thursday 29th July 2022**

After a two year absence, the New Forest Show is back this year. For the past fifty years, the Deanery has had a Church Tent offering Refreshments, Children's Activities and providing a wealth of resources from the Oasis Bookshop (from Romsey). In 2019, about 4000 cups of tea were served in the tent by a team of volunteers. Over the past two years, so much has changed and many of those who volunteered in the tent are no longer able to do so. All volunteers get a free Day Pass for the show. This is an opportunity to come together as a Deanery to serve our community, promote the place and importance of our Parish Churches and share the hospitality of God with the 1000's who visit the show.
